<p>Indications: Ceftazidime is a third generation cephalosporin with anti-pseudomonas activity used for bacterial infections. LRTI, SSTI, UTI, Bacterial Septicemia, Bone and Joint Infections, CNS infections, Gynec, Intra abdominal Infections</p>			
<p>Side-effects: were phlebitis and inflammation, Hypersensitivity Reactions, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain Hyperbilirubinemia, jaundice, renal impairment, CNS reactions- headache, dizziness, and paresthesia, seizures</p>			
<p>Precautions: , prolonged use of may result in overgrowth of nonsusceptible organisms, pregnancy, lactation, not in children under 12 years</p>			
<p>Contra-indications: hypersensitivity to ceftazidime or the cephalosporin group of antibiotics.</p>
