Indications: Acute infections caused by Salmonella typhi, H. influenzae, specifically meningeal infections, rickettsia, Lymphogranuloma-psittacosis group, gram-negative infections, Cystic fibrosis regimens				
Side-effects: bone marrow depression. Serious and fatal blood dyscrasias (aplastic anemia), hypoplastic anemia, thrombocytopenia and granulocytopenia, Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, headache, Hypersensitivity, gray baby syndrome				
Precautions: Impaired hepatic and renal function, preterm and full term neonate				
Contra-indications: Hypersensitivity, pregnancy, lactation, porphyria, pre-existing bone marrow depression
