20 mg	Enalapril Maleate USP 20 mg		
Indications: Hypertension, Heart Failure, Asymptomatic Left Ventricular Dysfunction			
Side-effects: Fatigue, orthostatic effects, asthenia, diarrhea, nausea, headache, dizziness, cough, rash			
Precautions: Impaired renal function, hyperkalaemia, hypovolemia, collagen vascular disease, valvular stenosis, anesthesia unilateral renal artery stenosis, hypotension due to volume depletion, diuretics, monitor WBC count. Lactation, children			
Contra-indications: Hypersensitivity to ACE inhibitors, bilateral renal artery stenosis, Pregnancy			
Overdose: treatment would be intravenous infusion of normal saline solution			
How to take: Take each dose with a full glass of water. Enalapril can be taken with or without food
